

Youth Program Tuition Rates September 6, 2011 through June 9, 2012

Registration Fees (Non Refundable)

Pre-Ballet I, Pre-Ballet II, Ballet A, Ballet B: \$50

New Students, Levels 1-7: \$125

Returning Students, Levels 1-7: \$75

Payment Due Dates

Plan I: Friday, September 9

Plan II: Friday, September 9, Friday, November 11

Plan III: Friday, September 9, Friday, November 11, Friday, January 13

Plan IV: Friday, September 9, Friday, November 11, Friday, January 13, Friday, March 11

Late Payments

A late fee of \$15.00 is applied to payments not received within one week of the due date.

A finance charge (1.5% per month or 18% annually) is applied to all balances not paid within 30 days.

Invoices are sent out for past due accounts only.

Discounts

For families with two or more children enrolled in the Youth Program a discount of 10% will be applied to the lesser tuition(s).

Enrollment Period

Enrollment is for a full school-year program.

Students who register after the start date (September 6) will have their tuition pro-rated.

Refunds

Tuition is not refunded for missed classes. Please see our policy on withdrawals (below) for more information.

Withdrawals

Withdrawals are fully acceptable in the case of a family move or student injury. Other cases for withdrawal should be discussed with the Artistic Director or the School Administrator before a final decision is made to refund tuition. Failure to attend class *does not* constitute a withdrawal. Tuition will not be refunded in this case.

The office must be notified of a withdrawal in writing. After written notice is received and approved by the Artistic Director or School Administrator, a refund will be given from the first of the new month. Please allow four weeks for the refund to be processed. Tuition may not be held as credit or carried over to the next school year.

Option II (Levels 4 and up)

Students in Levels 4 and who do not wish to enroll in the full program may participate in Option II. This program offers students the same instruction as the Youth Program without the commitment to attend the complete schedule of classes for their division. This is an excellent option for students who wish to pursue ballet on a recreational level or who have multiple school and family responsibilities. Students will still be eligible to perform in school productions, but should not expect to receive principal roles, which require substantial commitments of time and energy.
