Please allow us to take a moment to reach out and share with you exciting news about our continued efforts to provide quality ballet training and performances within our area. Western **Ballet** is a long-time established and respected **non-profit organization in Silicon Valley** that makes the art of classical ballet performances and education accessible and affordable to the general public, including low income families and underrepresented organizations. Western Ballet has also proved to be a highly valued institution in our community for its **impact on the spiritual, mental and physical health of our students**. The oldest non-profit institution in our area fully dedicated to the preservation of the art of classical ballet (43 years), we offer not only classes for all ages, but high-quality professional performances which continue to enhance our community's artistic landscape.

-Our year-round activities include 300+ youth students, of which around 30 receive scholarships or financial aid and participation in our **Youth Pre-Professional Program**. This program is designed to bring classical ballet education to students who otherwise wouldn't be able to afford exposure to this art. Students learn the necessary approach to successfully participate in the creative process and what it takes to become an integral part in the development of new works staged or created specifically on them by professional local and guest choreographers. They then get to perform these works for the general public and within this professional setting, live invaluable experiences that will help their future decisions whether or not a career in dance is chosen. As part of this program WB presents two annual full length "fairy tale" ballet productions and several mixed repertoire performances throughout the year.

-Our Outreach Programs include performances and lectures in Silicon Valley's public libraries, City events, and local retirement homes.

-Aside from its youth programing, Western Ballet has 1500+ registered adult students and offers 38 adult ballet classes weekly, starting at the Absolute Beginning level.

-Open 362 days a year, our institution was recently recognized as the best dance studio in *Best of Mountain View 2018/2019* for the Mountain View Voice, the local newspaper.


The estimated value of our current facilities is \$8,000,000. Towards this goal we have already raised \$175,000
